- Are you self motivated and have good time management?
- Do you earn A's and B's?
- Do you have good organizational skills?
- How are your communication skills?
- Are you responsible?
- Do you have high self expectations?

What are the advantages and disadvantages of CCP?

<u>Advantages</u>	<u>Disadvantages</u>
Earn College Credits	Courses may not transfer to private schools
Save money	You are responsible for the cost of the course if you do not pass or withdraw from a class too late
Expand curriculum	Course schedule may conflict with extra curricular activity schedule
Reduce time in college	Grades are on permanent transcript
	Colleges only communicate with students not their parents
	You are the responsible one for your grade and communicating with your professor, Claymont cannot help your class content
	Content is not adapted based on age

What are the differences between Kent and Stark State CCP?

Kent	Stark State
Off Campus - Travel	On Campus - Online Learning (until senior year, then go to campus)
Many courses to choose from	Many courses to choose from
Can earn an Associates Degree	Can earn an Associates Degree- Must begin classes as a freshman and may have to travel to Stark as a senior
Course count as both high school and college credits	Course count as both high school and college credits

How to apply

****For those who are currently enrolled at Kent, you will need to fill out a continuation form with Kent and fill out Garaway's Letter of Intent Form(office)****

Application Process for students new to CCP:

Step 1: Turn in the [Intent Form](#) to your high school by April 1 (Click the link or see your school counselor).

Step 2: Complete the online CCP application, being sure to make note of your Username and PIN (you will need these to access the application system in the future). Note: There is no paper application and you must **use the CCP application, not the New Freshman** application. There is no application fee.

Step 3: Print, complete and submit the CCP Permission Form.

Step 4: Request your high school send an up-to-date transcript to Kent State Tuscarawas. (You will need to let your counselor know to send your transcript)

Step 5: Be sure to have your ACT or SAT scores sent to Kent State Tuscarawas (send to code 3284).

Step 6: Watch your postal mail and email for updates about your application status.

Application Process for new CCP students:

New applicants need to follow these steps:

1. Fill out "[Letter of Intent to Participate](#)" at your high school by May 1st. (click the link or see your school counselor)
2. Complete our application, click [here](#). (https://www.starkstate.edu/admissions_form/) (Deadline is May 1st)
3. Have your counselor send your transcript to Stark State. (Send to admissions@starkstate.edu)
4. You will need to take an entrance exam. You may choose to take the ACT or the Accuplacer. (See your counselor for more information) (If you have already taken the accuplacer then skip this step)
5. Once accepted you will be able to register for classes. Once you register for classes please let Mrs. Njoroge (school counselor) know which classes you registered for.
